AN ACT to amend the public service law, in relation to the inspection and examination of apparatus by the agent of a utility or municipality and to repeal section 47 of such law relating thereto

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 Section 1. Section 47 of the public service law is REPEALED and a new
2 section 47 is added to read as follows:
3 S 47. INSPECTION AND EXAMINATION OF APPARATUS. 1. EXCEPT WHEN AN EMER-
4 GENCY MAY THREATEN THE HEALTH OR SAFETY OF A PERSON, THE SURROUNDING
5 AREA OR THE UTILITY'S OR MUNICIPALITY'S DISTRIBUTION SYSTEM OR WHERE
6 AUTHORIZED BY COURT ORDER, AN AGENT OF A UTILITY OR MUNICIPALITY, OTHER-
7 WISE DULY AUTHORIZED TO INSPECT AND EXAMINE APPARATUS MAY NOT ENTER
8 PREMISES, REGARDLESS OF WHETHER SUCH PREMISES ARE LOCKED OR UNLOCKED,
9 WITHOUT PERMISSION OF A PERSON LAWFULLY IN CONTROL OF THE PREMISES, NOR
10 USE ANY MANNER OF FORCE TO CARRY OUT SUCH INSPECTION AND EXAMINATION.
11 2. NOTWITHSTANDING SUBDIVISION ONE OF THIS SECTION, A DULY AUTHORIZED
12 AGENT OF A UTILITY CORPORATION OR MUNICIPALITY MAY ENTER THE COMMON AREA
13 OF A MULTIPLE DWELLING SUPPLIED WITH GAS OR ELECTRICITY BY THE UTILITY
14 CORPORATION OR MUNICIPALITY, FOR THE PURPOSE OF INSPECTING AND EXAMINING
15 THE METERS, PIPES, FITTINGS, WIRES AND OTHER APPARATUS FOR REGULATING,
16 SUPPLYING AND/OR ASCERTAINING THE QUANTITY SUPPLIED, UNDER THE FOLLOWING
17 TERMS AND CONDITIONS:
18 (A) THE AGENT EXHIBITS A PHOTO-IDENTIFICATION BADGE AND A WRITTEN
19 AUTHORITY SIGNED BY THE PRESIDENT OR VICE-PRESIDENT AND SECRETARY OR
20 ASSISTANT SECRETARY OF THE CORPORATION, OR BY THE MAYOR OR CLERK OF A
21 MUNICIPAL CORPORATION OR BY THE CHAIRPERSON AND SECRETARY OF A MUNICIPAL
22 BOARD IN CONTROL OF A MUNICIPAL UTILITY, AND
23 (B) ANY SUCH INSPECTION AND EXAMINATION SHALL BE CONDUCTED ON A
24 NON-HOLIDAY WORK DAY BETWEEN EIGHT A.M. AND SIX P.M. OR SUCH OTHER
25 REASONABLE TIME REQUESTED BY THE CUSTOMER, EXCEPT WHEN AN EMERGENCY MAY
26 THREATEN THE HEALTH OR SAFETY OF A PERSON, THE SURROUNDING AREA OR THE

1 UTILITY'S OR MUNICIPALITY'S DISTRIBUTION SYSTEM, OR EXCEPT WHEN THE
2 COMMISSION BY REGULATION ESTABLISHES A DIFFERENT TIME FOR THE INSPECTION
3 AND EXAMINATION WHERE THERE IS EVIDENCE OF METER TAMPERING OR THEFT OF
4 SERVICES.

5 S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
