AN ACT to amend the public health law, in relation to exempting non-resident students at community colleges from the requirement of maintaining measles, mumps and rubella (MMR) and meningococcal meningitis records

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 Section 1. Section 2165 of the public health law is amended by adding
2 a new subdivision 14 to read as follows:
3 14. THIS SECTION SHALL NOT APPLY TO NON-RESIDENT STUDENTS AT COMMUNITY
4 COLLEGES AS DEFINED IN SUBDIVISION TWO OF SECTION SIXTY-THREE HUNDRED
5 ONE OF THE EDUCATION LAW.
6 S 2. Section 2167 of the public health law is amended by adding a new
7 subdivision 7 to read as follows:
8 7. THIS SECTION SHALL NOT APPLY TO NONRESIDENT STUDENTS AT COMMUNITY
9 COLLEGES AS DEFINED IN SUBDIVISION TWO OF SECTION SIXTY-THREE HUNDRED
10 ONE OF THE EDUCATION LAW.
11 S 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
