AN ACT to amend the agriculture and markets law, in relation to establishing a registry for persons convicted of violating "Buster's Law"

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEM-BLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The agriculture and markets law is amended by adding a new 2 section 352 to read as follows:

3 ANIMAL CRUELTY REGISTER. ANY PERSON WHO IS CONVICTED OF A 352. SECTION THREE HUNDRED FIFTY-ONE VIOLATION OF OR THREE FIFTY-THREE-A OF THIS ARTICLE SHALL REGISTER WITH THE DEPARTMENT. SUCH REGISTRATION SHALL BE MADE IN A MANNER AND FORM TO BE DETERMINED BY THE 6 7 DEPARTMENT, AND SHALL INCLUDE, AT A MINIMUM, THE NAME AND ADDRESS OF SUCH REGISTRANT. THE DEPARTMENT SHALL MAINTAIN REGISTRATION INFORMATION 9 RECEIVED PURSUANT TO THIS SECTION IN A REGISTRY. SUCH REGISTRY SHALL BE 10 IN PRINT AND IN ELECTRONIC FORM AND SHALL BE AVAILABLE TO 11 ENFORCEMENT ENTITIES, DISTRICT ATTORNEYS, DULY INCORPORATED HUMANE SOCI-ETIES, SOCIETIES FOR THE PREVENTION OF CRUELTY TO ANIMALS, DOG OR CAT 12 PROTECTIVE ASSOCIATIONS, ANIMAL CONTROL OFFICERS, BREEDERS OF ANIMALS 13 14 STORES DOING BUSINESS IN THIS STATE. ANY PERSON REQUIRED TO PETREGISTER PURSUANT TO THIS SECTION SHALL REGISTER ANNUALLY, OR EACH 15 16 SUCH PERSON MOVES TO A NEW ADDRESS AND SHALL CONTINUE TO REGISTER UNTIL SUCH PERSON RECEIVES A COURT ORDER ORDERING SUCH REGISTRATION TO CEASE. 17 SUCH ORDER SHALL BE ISSUED UNTIL SUCH PERSON FIRST DEMONSTRATES TO 18 19 THE COURT THAT HE OR SHE HAS UNDERGONE PSYCHIATRIC OR PSYCHOLOGICAL 20 THE RESULTS OF WHICH INDICATE BY CLEAR AND CONVINCING EVIDENCE TESTING, 21 HIS OR HER CAPABLE AND SOUND MENTAL CAPACITY AND ABILITY TO OWN AND 22 PROPERLY CARE FOR AN ANIMAL IN A HUMANE MANNER. ANY PERSON REQUIRED TO 23 REGISTER PURSUANT TO THIS SECTION SHALL NOT OWN A COMPANION ANIMAL OR AN ANIMAL SHELTER, POUND, PET STORE, ZOO OR OTHER 24 EMPLOYMENT AT 25 BUSINESS ESTABLISHMENT WHERE COMPANION ANIMALS ARE PRESENT. ANY PERSON IS CONVICTED OF A VIOLATION OF SECTION THREE HUNDRED FIFTY-ONE OR 27 THREE HUNDRED FIFTY-THREE-A OF THIS ARTICLE SHALL, IN ADDITION TO ANY OTHER PENALTY OR TERM OF IMPRISONMENT AUTHORIZED BY LAW, BE SUBJECT TO A
