AN ACT to amend the correction law, in relation to written statements upon denial of a license

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. Section 754 of the correction law, as added by chapter 931 2 of the laws of 1976, is amended to read as follows:

S 754. Written statement upon denial of license or employment OR OTHER ADVERSE ACTION. At the request of any person previously convicted of one or more criminal offenses who has been denied a license or employment OR AGAINST WHOM AN ADVERSE ACTION HAS BEEN TAKEN WITH RESPECT TO A LICENSE OR EMPLOYMENT, a public agency or private employer shall provide, within thirty days of a request, a written statement setting forth the reasons for such denial OR ADVERSE ACTION.

S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
