AN ACT to amend the environmental conservation law, in relation to prohibiting the distribution and use of paper containing bisphenol A for the recording of any business transaction

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEM-BLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. The environmental conservation law is amended by adding a new section 37-0508 to read as follows:
- S 37-0508. TRANSACTION PAPER.
- NO PERSON, FIRM, PARTNERSHIP, ASSOCIATION, LIMITED LIABILITY COMPANY OR CORPORATION, INCLUDING BANKING ORGANIZATIONS, SHALL DISTRIBUTE OR USE ANY PAPER CONTAINING BISPHENOL A FOR THE RECORDING OF ANY BUSINESS OR
- BANKING TRANSACTION INCLUDING, BUT NOT LIMITED TO, RECEIPTS, CREDITS, WITHDRAWALS, DEPOSITS, AND CREDIT AND DEBIT CARD RECORDS. 7
- 9 S 2. This act shall take effect on the one hundred eightieth day after it shall have become a law. 10
