AN ACT to amend the general municipal law, in relation to requiring police officers to be retrained in cardiopulmonary resuscitation every two years

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 Section 1. Short title. This act shall be known and may be cited as 2 "Briana's Law".
- S 2. The general municipal law is amended by adding a new section 208-h to read as follows:
- 5 S 208-H. BIENNIAL POLICE OFFICER CARDIOPULMONARY RESUSCITATION 6 RETRAINING. EVERY POLICE OFFICER SHALL, EVERY TWO YEARS BE:
- 7 1. RETRAINED IN CARDIOPULMONARY RESUSCITATION AS DEFINED BY SUBDIVI-8 SION SIX OF SECTION SIX HUNDRED TWENTY-ONE OF THE GENERAL BUSINESS LAW; 9 AND
- 10 2. REQUIRED TO DEMONSTRATE THE SATISFACTORY COMPLETION OF TRAINING IN 11 CARDIOPULMONARY RESUSCITATION.
- 12 S 3. This act shall take effect on the sixtieth day after it shall 13 have become a law.
