AN ACT to amend the vehicle and traffic law, in relation to the display
of number plates on historical motor vehicles

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEM-
BLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. Subdivision 1 of section 402 of the vehicle and traffic
2 law, as amended by chapter 109 of the laws of 2005, is amended to read
3 as follows:

4 1. (a) No person shall operate, drive or park a motor vehicle on the
5 public highways of this state unless such vehicle shall have a distinc-
6 tive number assigned to it by the commissioner and a set of number
7 plates issued by the commissioner with a number and other identification
8 matter if any, corresponding to that of the certificate of registration
9 conspicuously displayed, one on the front and one on the rear of such
10 vehicle (EXCEPT IN THE CASE OF A VEHICLE REGISTERED AS A HISTORICAL
11 MOTOR VEHICLE PURSUANT TO SCHEDULE G OF SUBDIVISION SEVEN OF SECTION
12 FOUR HUNDRED ONE OF THIS ARTICLE, IN WHICH CASE SUCH VEHICLE NEED
13 DISPLAY ONLY ONE NUMBER PLATE ON THE REAR THEREOF), each securely
14 fastened so as to prevent the same from swinging and placed, whenever
15 reasonably possible, not higher than forty-eight inches and not lower
16 than twelve inches from the ground; provided, however, that in any
17 registration year for which only one number plate is issued, such number
18 plate shall constitute a set of number plates for the time in which such
19 use is authorized, shall be displayed on the rear of the vehicle and
20 none shall be displayed on its front, except in case of a tractor, when
21 such number plate shall be displayed on the front of the vehicle and
22 none shall be displayed on its rear.

23 (b) Number plates shall be kept clean and in a condition so as to be
24 easily readable and shall not be covered by glass or any plastic materi-

1 al, and shall not be knowingly covered or coated with any artificial or
2 synthetic material or substance that conceals or obscures such number
3 plates or that distorts a recorded or photographic image of such number
4 plates, and the view of such number plates shall not be obstructed by
5 any part of the vehicle or by anything carried thereon, except for a
6 receiver-transmitter issued by a publicly owned tolling facility in
7 connection with electronic toll collection when such receiver-transmit-
8 ter is affixed to the exterior of a vehicle in accordance with mounting
9 instructions provided by the tolling facility.
10 S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
