AN ACT to amend the election law, in relation to employment of election  
inspectors

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEM-  
BLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. Section 3-400 of the election law is amended by adding a  
2 new subdivision 7 to read as follows:

3 7. THE BOARD OF ELECTIONS MAY EMPLOY ELECTION INSPECTORS TO WORK  
4 HALF-DAY SHIFTS WITH ADJUSTED COMPENSATION, PROVIDED, HOWEVER, THAT AT  
5 LEAST ONE INSPECTOR FROM EACH OF THE TWO MAJOR POLITICAL PARTIES IS  
6 PRESENT AT THE POLL SITE FOR THE ENTIRE TIME THAT THE POLLS ARE OPEN.  
7 EACH COUNTY BOARD OF ELECTIONS SHALL PRESCRIBE THE NECESSARY RULES AND  
8 PROCEDURES TO ENSURE PROPER POLL SITE OPERATION.

9 S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
