AN ACT to exempt veterans of World War II from any additional fees when they order license plates stating "World War II Veteran"

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The department of motor vehicles shall establish that there shall be no charge for the issuance or renewal of a license plate stating "World War II Veteran", upon payment of the regular registration fee prescribed by section 401 of the vehicle and traffic law, when such plate is being issued upon proof, satisfactory to the commissioner of motor vehicles, that the applicant is a veteran of World War II.
