AN ACT to amend the real property law, in relation to requiring the disclosure, upon the sale or lease of residential real property, of the availability of certain sex offender information

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEM-BLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The real property law is amended by adding two new sections 2 220-a and 242-a to read as follows:

3 S 220-A. DISCLOSURE OF THE AVAILABILITY OF SEX OFFENDER INFORMATION. 4 1. EVERY LEASE AND RENTAL AGREEMENT OF RESIDENTIAL REAL PROPERTY SHALL 5 CONTAIN IN NOT LESS THAN EIGHT POINT TYPE, THE FOLLOWING NOTICE:

6 "NOTICE: THE NEW YORK STATE DIVISION OF CRIMINAL JUSTICE SERVICES 7 MAINTAINS AND DISTRIBUTES A SUBDIRECTORY, WHICH IS A BOOK THAT PROVIDES LOCATION OF LEVEL TWO AND THREE SEX OFFENDERS REQUIRED TO REGISTER 8 THE 9 PURSUANT TO ARTICLE 6-C OF THE CORRECTION LAW, THE SEX OFFENDER REGIS-10 TO THE OFFICES OF LOCAL VILLAGE, TOWN, CITY AND COUNTY TRATION ACT, POLICE DEPARTMENTS AND STATE LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCIES FOR THE PURPOSE OF 11 PUBLIC ACCESS. PLEASE CONTACT YOUR LOCAL LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCY FOR 12 FURTHER INFORMATION ON HOW TO ACCESS AND VIEW THE SUBDIRECTORY OF LEVEL 13 14 TWO AND THREE SEX OFFENDERS. THE NEW YORK STATE DIVISION OF CRIMINAL ALSO OPERATES FOR PUBLIC ACCESS A SPECIAL "900" TELE-15 JUSTICE SERVICES 16 PHONE NUMBER THROUGH WHICH CALLERS MAY VERIFY THE REGISTRATION OF А CALLERS MUST HAVE SPECIFIC INFORMATION WHICH WILL 17 NAMED INDIVIDUAL. ACHIEVE POSITIVE IDENTIFICATION SUCH AS AN 18 EXACT ADDRESS, DRIVER'S 19 LICENSE NUMBER OR BIRTH DATE."

20 2. SUBJECT TO THE PROVISIONS OF SUBDIVISION THREE OF THIS SECTION, 21 UPON DELIVERY OF THE NOTICE REQUIRED PURSUANT TO SUBDIVISION ONE OF THIS 22 SECTION TO THE LESSEE OF THE REAL PROPERTY, NEITHER THE LESSOR NOR ANY

AGENT OF THE LESSOR SHALL BE REQUIRED TO PROVIDE INFORMATION IN ADDITION 1 TO THAT CONTAINED IN THE NOTICE REGARDING THE AVAILABILITY OF THE SUBDI-2 RECTORY AND SPECIAL "900" NUMBER. 13 S 242-A. DISCLOSURE OF THE AVAILABILITY OF SEX OFFENDER INFORMATION. 14 1. EVERY CONTRACT FOR THE PURCHASE OF RESIDENTIAL REAL PROPERTY, 15 COMPRISING ONE TO FOUR DWELLING UNITS, SHALL CONTAIN IN NOT LESS THAN 16 EIGHT POINT TYPE, THE FOLLOWING NOTICE:

"NOTICE: THE NEW YORK STATE DIVISION OF CRIMINAL JUSTICE SERVICES 17 MAINTAINS AND DISTRIBUTES A SUBDIRECTORY, WHICH IS A BOOK THAT PROVIDES 18 THE LOCATION OF LEVEL TWO AND THREE SEX OFFENDERS REQUIRED TO REGISTER 19 PURSUANT TO ARTICLE 6-C OF THE CORRECTION LAW, THE SEX OFFENDER REGIS-20 21 TRATION ACT, TO THE OFFICES OF LOCAL VILLAGE, TOWN, CITY AND COUNTY POLICE DEPARTMENTS AND STATE LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCIES FOR THE PURPOSE OF 22 PUBLIC ACCESS. PLEASE CONTACT YOUR LOCAL LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCY FOR 23 FURTHER INFORMATION ON HOW TO ACCESS AND VIEW THE SUBDIRECTORY OF LEVEL 24 25 TWO AND THREE SEX OFFENDERS. THE NEW YORK STATE DIVISION OF CRIMINAL JUSTICE SERVICES ALSO OPERATES FOR PUBLIC ACCESS A SPECIAL "900" TELE-26 27 PHONE NUMBER THROUGH WHICH CALLERS MAY VERIFY THE REGISTRATION OF A NAMED INDIVIDUAL. CALLERS MUST HAVE SPECIFIC INFORMATION WHICH WILL 28 ACHIEVE POSITIVE IDENTIFICATION SUCH AS AN EXACT ADDRESS, DRIVER'S 29 LICENSE NUMBER OR BIRTH DATE." 30

SUBJECT TO THE PROVISIONS OF SUBDIVISION THREE OF THIS SECTION, 31 32 UPON DELIVERY OF THE NOTICE REQUIRED PURSUANT TO SUBDIVISION ONE OF THIS SECTION TO THE BUYER OF THE REAL PROPERTY, NEITHER THE GRANTEE NOR ANY 33 AGENT OF THE GRANTEE SHALL BE REQUIRED TO PROVIDE INFORMATION IN ADDI-34 35 TION TO THAT CONTAINED IN THE NOTICE REGARDING THE AVAILABILITY OF THE SUBDIRECTORY AND SPECIAL "900" NUMBER.
