AN ACT to amend the tax law, in relation to making monetary gifts to libraries

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Subsection (c) of section 612 of the tax law is amended by adding a new paragraph 39 to read as follows:

- (39) AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED TWO HUNDRED DOLLARS FOR MONETARY GIFTS TO ANY LIBRARY IN THE STATE OF NEW YORK AS DEFINED UNDER SECTION TWO HUNDRED FIFTY-THREE OF THE EDUCATION LAW. THE MONEY MUST BE USED BY THE PARTICULAR LIBRARY ONLY FOR THE PURCHASE OF BOOKS AND LIBRARY MATERIALS OR TOWARDS THE ACQUISITION OF COMPUTERS AND SOFTWARE BY THE LIBRARY. WHEN THE GIFT OR GIFTS ARE MADE BY THE INDIVIDUAL, THE LIBRARY SHALL PROVIDE THAT INDIVIDUAL WITH AN OFFICIAL RECEIPT.
