AN ACT to amend the penal law, in relation to lawful possession of weapons by persons eleven years of age

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEM-BLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Subdivision a of section 265.20 of the penal law is amended by adding a new paragraph 7-f to read as follows:

7-F. POSSESSION AND USE, AT AN INDOOR OR OUTDOOR SHOOTING RANGE, THE LAYOUT AND OPERATION OF WHICH CONFORM TO GUIDELINES AND OPERATING STAND-ARDS ESTABLISHED BY THE NATIONAL COUNCIL OF THE BOY SCOUTS OF AMERICA, THEPURPOSE OF LOADING AND FIRING OF A SINGLE SHOT .22 CALIBER RIFLE, THE PROPELLING FORCE OF WHICH IS GUNPOWDER, BY A PERSON 7 8 IMMEDIATE SUPERVISION, GUIDANCE AND YEARS OF AGE WHO IS UNDER THE9 INSTRUCTION OF (A) A DULY COMMISSIONED OFFICER OF THE UNITED ARMY, NAVY, MARINE CORPS, AIR FORCE OR COAST GUARD, OR OF THE NATIONAL 10 GUARD OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK; OR (B) A DULY QUALIFIED ADULT CITIZEN OF 11 THE UNITED STATES AT LEAST TWENTY-ONE YEARS OF AGE WHO 12 (I) HAS GRANTED A CERTIFICATE AS A RIFLE INSTRUCTOR ISSUED BY THE UNITED STATES 13 14 ARMY, NAVY, MARINE CORPS, AIR FORCE OR COAST GUARD, OR BY THE ADJUTANT GENERAL OF THIS STATE, OR BY THE NATIONAL RIFLE ASSOCIATION OF AMERICA, 15 A NOT-FOR-PROFIT CORPORATION DULY ORGANIZED UNDER THE LAWS 16 OF 17 STATE, OR (II) HAS BEEN CERTIFIED AS A SHOOTING SPORTS DIRECTOR BY A BOY SCOUTS OF AMERICA NATIONAL CAMPING SCHOOL. 18

19 S 2. This act shall take effect on the first of November next succeeding the date on which it shall have become a law. 20
