AN ACT to amend the elder law, in relation to creating and distributing a drug guide for senior consumers

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEM-BLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. The elder law is amended by adding a new section 224 to 2 read as follows:
- S 224. SENIOR DRUG GUIDE. THE DIRECTOR, IN CONJUNCTION WITH THE
- BOARD OF PHARMACY, AND AFTER CONSULTATION WITH THE STATE CONSUMER PROTECTION BOARD, SHALL WITHIN AMOUNTS MADE AVAILABLE BY APPROPRIATION
- THEREFOR PREPARE AND PUBLISH A GUIDE EXPLAINING THE PURPOSE, FUNCTION,
- 7 AND COMMON DRUG INTERACTIONS OF DRUGS COMMONLY USED BY PERSONS OVER 8 OF SIXTY-TWO. THE DIRECTOR SHALL TAKE SUCH ACTIONS AS SHALL BE
- NECESSARY AND APPROPRIATE TO MAKE SUCH GUIDE AVAILABLE TO INDIVIDUALS 9
- UPON REQUEST AND WITHOUT CHARGE THROUGH DESIGNATED AGENCIES, AS SUCH 10
- TERM IS DEFINED IN SECTION TWO HUNDRED FOURTEEN OF THIS TITLE, 11
- THAT REOUESTS FOR MORE THAN TEN COPIES SHALL BE SUBJECT TO A NOMINAL 12
- CHARGE TO COVER THE COST OF REPRODUCTION AND HANDLING. 13
- S 2. This act shall take effect on the first of 14 September next
- succeeding the date on which it shall have become a law. 15
