AN ACT to amend the election law, in relation to the hours for conducting voting in the city of New York

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. Subdivision 2 of section 8-100 of the election law, as
2 amended by chapter 335 of the laws of 2000, is amended to read as
3 follows:
4 2. Polls shall be open for voting during the following hours: a primary
5 election from twelve o'clock noon until nine o'clock in the evening,
6 except in the city of New York and the counties of Nassau, Suffolk,
7 Westchester, Rockland, Orange, Putnam and Erie, and in such city or
8 county from [six] SEVEN o'clock in the morning until nine o'clock in the
9 evening; the general election from [six] SEVEN o'clock in the morning
10 until nine o'clock in the evening; a special election called by the
11 governor pursuant to the public officers law, and, except as otherwise
12 provided by law, every other election, from [six] SEVEN o'clock in the
13 morning until nine o'clock in the evening.
14 S 2. This act shall take effect on the ninetieth day after it shall
15 have become a law.
