AN ACT to amend the executive law, in relation to authorizing the secretary of state to accept service of process and receipt of mail on behalf of victims of domestic violence for the purpose of maintaining the confidentiality of the location of such victims

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. The executive law is amended by adding a new section 108 to
2 read as follows:

3 S 108. SERVICE OF PROCESS AND RECEIPT OF MAIL; VICTIMS OF DOMESTIC
4 VIOLENCE. 1. DEFINITIONS. FOR THE PURPOSES OF THIS SECTION:

5 (A) "ACTUAL ADDRESS" SHALL MEAN THE RESIDENTIAL STREET ADDRESS, SCHOOL
6 ADDRESS OR WORK ADDRESS OF A VICTIM OF DOMESTIC VIOLENCE.

7 (B) "VICTIM OF DOMESTIC VIOLENCE" SHALL HAVE THE SAME MEANING AS IS
8 ASCRIBED TO SUCH TERM PURSUANT TO SECTION FOUR HUNDRED FIFTY-NINE-A OF
9 THE SOCIAL SERVICES LAW.

10 2. A VICTIM OF DOMESTIC VIOLENCE MAY MAKE APPLICATION TO THE SECRETARY
11 OF STATE TO HAVE AN ADDRESS DESIGNATED BY THE DEPARTMENT OF STATE TO
12 SERVE AS THE ADDRESS OF SUCH VICTIM IN LIEU OF THE VICTIM'S ACTUAL
13 ADDRESS. THE SECRETARY OF STATE SHALL ESTABLISH, DISTRIBUTE AND MAKE
14 AVAILABLE A FORM FOR THE PURPOSE OF MAKING APPLICATIONS PURSUANT TO THIS
15 SECTION. SUCH FORMS SHALL BE PROVIDED TO THE OFFICE OF CHILDREN AND
16 FAMILY SERVICES, THE OFFICE FOR THE PREVENTION OF DOMESTIC VIOLENCE, THE
17 DEPARTMENT OF MOTOR VEHICLES AND COUNTY BOARDS OF ELECTIONS FOR THE
18 PURPOSE OF DISTRIBUTION OF SUCH FORMS TO VICTIMS OF DOMESTIC VIOLENCE.

19 3. UPON RECEIPT OF AN APPLICATION, THE SECRETARY OF STATE SHALL GRANT
20 APPROVAL TO SUCH APPLICATION IF IT INCLUDES:

21 (A) A SIGNED WRITTEN STATEMENT SWEARING AND AFFIRMING:

1 (I) THAT THE APPLICANT IS A VICTIM OF DOMESTIC VIOLENCE,
2 (II) THAT THE APPLICANT HAS BEEN FORCED TO LEAVE HIS OR HER ACTUAL
3 ADDRESS BECAUSE OF SUCH VIOLENCE, AND

4 (III) THAT BECAUSE OF THE THREAT OF PHYSICAL HARM TO THE APPLICANT OR
5 HIS OR HER CHILD OR CHILDREN, SUCH APPLICANT DESIGNATES THE SECRETARY OF
6 STATE AS HIS OR HER AGENT FOR PURPOSES OF SERVICE OF PROCESS AND RECEIPT
7 OF MAIL;

8 (B) THE ACTUAL ADDRESS WHERE THE VICTIM OF DOMESTIC VIOLENCE CAN BE
9 CONTACTED BY THE SECRETARY OF STATE, AND TELEPHONE NUMBER AT WHICH THE
10 VICTIM OF DOMESTIC VIOLENCE CAN BE CALLED BY THE SECRETARY OF STATE; AND

11 (C) THE ADDRESS OR ADDRESSES THAT THE VICTIM OF DOMESTIC VIOLENCE
12 REQUESTS NOT BE DISCLOSED FOR THE REASON THAT DISCLOSURE WOULD INCREASE
13 THE RISK OF DOMESTIC VIOLENCE.

14 4. UPON APPROVAL OF AN APPLICATION SUBMITTED PURSUANT TO THIS SECTION,
15 THE SECRETARY OF STATE SHALL SERVE AS THE APPLICANT'S AGENT FOR THE
16 SERVICE OF PROCESS AND RECEIPT OF MAIL FOR A PERIOD OF FOUR YEARS FROM
17 THE DATE SUCH APPLICATION IS APPROVED, UNLESS THE APPLICATION IS WITH-
18 DRAWN OR INVALIDATED PRIOR TO THE EXPIRATION OF SUCH PERIOD OF TIME.
19 THE SECRETARY OF STATE SHALL PROMULGATE RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR THE
20 RENEWAL OF APPLICATIONS PURSUANT TO THIS SECTION.

21 5. SERVICE UPON THE SECRETARY OF STATE OF ANY PROCESS OR MAIL SHALL BE
22 MADE TO AN ADDRESS DESIGNATED BY THE DEPARTMENT OF STATE FOR THE INDI-
23 VIDUAL VICTIM OF DOMESTIC VIOLENCE. UPON RECEIPT BY THE SECRETARY OF
24 STATE OF A PROCESS OR MAIL FOR A VICTIM OF DOMESTIC VIOLENCE, THE
25 DEPARTMENT OF STATE SHALL IMMEDIATELY FORWARD SUCH PROCESS OR MAIL TO
26 THE VICTIM OF DOMESTIC VIOLENCE AT HIS OR HER ACTUAL ADDRESS, AND SHALL
27 RECORD THE DATE OF SUCH FORWARDING. THE SECRETARY OF STATE AND THE
28 DEPARTMENT OF STATE SHALL BE HELD HARMLESS FROM ANY LIABILITY AS THE
29 RESULT OF HANDLING ANY PROCESS OR MAIL ON BEHALF OF A VICTIM OF DOMESTIC
30 VIOLENCE.

31 6. THE DEPARTMENT OF STATE SHALL TERMINATE THE SECRETARY OF STATE'S
32 AGENCY ON BEHALF OF A VICTIM OF DOMESTIC VIOLENCE:

33 (A) IF THE VICTIM OF DOMESTIC VIOLENCE OBTAINS A NAME CHANGE;

34 (B) IF PROCESS OR MAIL IS RETURNED TO THE DEPARTMENT OF STATE AS UNDE-
35 LIVERABLE TO THE ACTUAL ADDRESS OF A VICTIM OF DOMESTIC VIOLENCE;

36 (C) IF THE VICTIM OF DOMESTIC VIOLENCE CHANGES HIS OR HER ACTUAL
37 ADDRESS, WITHOUT PROVIDING THE DEPARTMENT OF STATE WITH WRITTEN NOTICE
38 OF SUCH ADDRESS CHANGE NOT LESS THAN SEVEN DAYS PRIOR THERETO; OR

39 (D) IF THE VICTIM OF DOMESTIC VIOLENCE PROVIDED FALSE INFORMATION IN
40 HIS OR HER APPLICATION.

41 7. ALL RECORDS AND DOCUMENTS HELD BY THE DEPARTMENT OF STATE PURSUANT
42 TO THIS SECTION ARE CONFIDENTIAL, UNLESS A COURT ORDER DIRECTS DISCLO-
43 SURE FOR THE PURPOSES OF A CRIMINAL OR CIVIL PROCEEDING. THE RECORDS
44 AND DOCUMENTS ON EACH VICTIM OF DOMESTIC VIOLENCE SHALL BE RETAINED BY
45 SUCH DEPARTMENT FOR THREE YEARS AFTER THE EXPIRATION OF THE APPROVAL OF
46 AN APPLICATION AND ANY RENEWAL THEREOF, AND THEREAFTER DESTROYED.

47 8. THE SECRETARY OF STATE SHALL PROMULGATE ANY AND ALL RULES AND REGU-
48 LATIONS NECESSARY TO IMPLEMENT THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SECTION.

49 S 2. This act shall take effect on the first of January next succeed-
50 ing the date on which it shall have become a law; provided, however,
51 that the secretary of state is authorized and directed to promulgate all
52 rules, regulations and forms necessary to implement the provisions of
53 this act, on its effective date, on or before such date.
