AN ACT to amend the county law, in relation to the availability of calls made to a municipality's E911 system

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. Subdivision 4 of section 308 of the county law, as amended
2 by chapter 309 of the laws of 1996, is amended to read as follows:
3 4. Records, in whatever form they may be kept, of calls made to a
4 municipality's E911 system [shall] NEED not be made available to or
5 obtained by any entity or person, other than that municipality's public
6 safety agency, another government agency or body, or a private entity or
7 a person providing medical, ambulance or other emergency services, and
8 shall not be utilized for any commercial purpose other than the
9 provision of emergency services; PROVIDED, HOWEVER, THAT A MUNICIPALITY
10 MAY DISCLOSE ANY PORTION OF SUCH RECORDS IN ANY EMERGENCY SITUATION TO
11 PROTECT PUBLIC SAFETY OR UPON THE CONSENT OF PERSONS WHO MADE SUCH
12 CALLS.
13 S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
