AN ACT to amend the correction law, in relation to notice whenever a sex offender is released to a public housing residence

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. Section 168-b of the correction law is amended by adding a
2 new subdivision 12 to read as follows:
3 12. THE DIVISION SHALL MAKE REGISTRY INFORMATION REGARDING LEVEL TWO
4 AND THREE SEX OFFENDERS AVAILABLE TO MUNICIPAL HOUSING AUTHORITIES, AS
5 ESTABLISHED PURSUANT TO ARTICLE THREE OF THE PUBLIC HOUSING LAW, TO
6 ENABLE SUCH AUTHORITIES TO IDENTIFY PERSONS INELIGIBLE TO RESIDE IN
7 PUBLIC HOUSING. THE DIVISION SHALL, AT LEAST MONTHLY, RELEASE TO EACH
8 MUNICIPAL HOUSING AUTHORITY INFORMATION ABOUT LEVEL TWO AND THREE SEX
9 OFFENDERS WITH A HOME ADDRESS AND/OR EXPECTED PLACE OF DOMICILE WITHIN
10 THE CORRESPONDING MUNICIPALITY. THE DIVISION MAY PROMULGATE RULES AND
11 REGULATIONS RELATING TO PROCEDURES FOR THE RELEASE OF INFORMATION IN THE
12 REGISTRY TO SUCH AUTHORITIES.
13 S 2. This act shall take effect on the sixtieth day after it shall
14 have become a law.
