- AN ACT to amend the environmental conservation law, in relation to requiring state agencies to report on greenhouse gas emissions as a result of their operations

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. The opening paragraph of subdivision 1 of section 3-0311 of 2 the environmental conservation law, as amended by chapter 741 of the 3 laws of 1991, is amended and a new paragraph d is added to read as 4 follows:

Each state agency as defined in subdivision five of this section shall 5 б annually audit the environmental problems created by its operations or 7 operations of contractors it has hired and over whom it has exerthe cised or is required to exercise direct oversight, acting in fulfillment 8 of their contracts. Such audit shall identify the extent to which these 9 10 operations are in violation of this chapter, or regulations adopted thereunder. IN ADDITION, EACH SUCH STATE 11 AGENCY SHALL CALCULATE THE GREENHOUSE GAS EMITTED AS A RESULT OF THEIR OPERATIONS. Each 12 AMOUNT OF such state agency shall submit a report to the department on or before 13 April first of each year. The report shall: 14

15 D. DESCRIBE THE GREENHOUSE GAS EMISSIONS AS A RESULT OF THEIR OPER-16 ATIONS, STEPS TAKEN TO REDUCE SUCH EMISSIONS, AND POSSIBLE FURTHER 17 ACTIONS TO REDUCE SUCH EMISSIONS.

18 S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
