- AN ACT to amend the economic development law, the New York state urban development corporation act and the executive law, in relation to small business crime prevention services

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. The economic development law is amended by adding a new 2 section 139 to read as follows:

3 S 139. SMALL BUSINESS CRIME PREVENTION SERVICES PROGRAM. 1. THERE IS 4 HEREBY ESTABLISHED WITHIN THE DIVISION A SMALL BUSINESS CRIME PREVENTION 5 SERVICES PROGRAM.

6 2. THE SMALL BUSINESS CRIME PREVENTION SERVICES PROGRAM, DIRECTLY AND
7 IN CONJUNCTION WITH OTHER DIVISIONS OF THE DEPARTMENT AND WITH OTHER
8 AGENCIES OF THE STATE, FEDERAL AGENCIES OR LOCAL GOVERNMENTS, SHALL
9 PROVIDE SMALL BUSINESSES WITH ACCESS TO THE FOLLOWING SERVICES:

10 (A) INFORMATION ON STRATEGIES, BEST PRACTICES AND PROGRAMS OFFERING 11 TRAINING AND ASSISTANCE IN PREVENTION OF CRIMES IN AND AROUND THE PREM-12 OF SMALL BUSINESSES OR OTHERWISE AFFECTING ISES SMALL BUSINESSES, 13 INCLUDING BUT NOT LIMITED TO: ASSAULT, ARSON AND OTHER VIOLENT FELONY 14 OFFENSES; ROBBERY, BURGLARY, THEFT, IDENTITY THEFT AND FRAUD; AND VANDALISM, GRAFFITI AND OTHER PROPERTY DAMAGE; 15

16 (B) INFORMATION ON ELIGIBILITY AND APPLICATIONS FOR FINANCIAL ASSIST-17 ANCE FOR SMALL BUSINESS CRIME PREVENTION SERVICES UNDER PARAGRAPH (L) OF 18 SUBDIVISION ONE OF SECTION SIXTEEN-M OF SECTION ONE OF CHAPTER ONE 19 HUNDRED SEVENTY-FOUR OF THE LAWS OF NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-EIGHT;

(C) INFORMATION ON ELIGIBILITY AND APPLICATIONS FOR OTHER PROGRAMS OF
 FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE FOR SMALL BUSINESS CRIME PREVENTION THAT MAY FROM
 TIME TO TIME BE AVAILABLE FROM THE DEPARTMENT OR OTHER AGENCIES OF THE
 STATE, FEDERAL AGENCIES OR LOCAL GOVERNMENTS;

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INFORMATION ON PROTECTING THE ASSETS OF SMALL BUSINESSES FROM 1 (D) 2 CRIME, INCLUDING RISK REDUCTION STRATEGIES AND INSURANCE AVAILABILITY; 3 AND 4 (E) INFORMATION ON RESPONSES TO CRIME, INCLUDING REPORTING OF CRIMES, 5 SUBMITTING INSURANCE CLAIMS AND CRIME VICTIM ASSISTANCE PROGRAMS. 6 3. THE SMALL BUSINESS CRIME PREVENTION SERVICES PROGRAM SHALL, WITH 7 ASSISTANCE OF THE SMALL BUSINESS ADVISORY BOARD AND OTHER APPROPRI-THE 8 ATE STATE AGENCIES, IDENTIFY ISSUES RELATING TO CRIME AFFECTING SMALL BUSINESSES AND ASSIST THE ADVISORY BOARD AND THE DIVISION IN MAKING 9 10 RECOMMENDATIONS FOR LEGISLATIVE, REGULATORY AND PROGRAMMATIC ACTIONS ТО 11 ADDRESS SUCH ISSUES. 12 Paragraph (k) of subdivision 1 of section 16-m of section 1 of S 2. chapter 174 of the laws of 1968, constituting the New York state urban 13 14 development corporation act, as added by section 4 of part FF of chapter 15 59 of the laws of 2006, is amended and a new paragraph (1) is added to 16 read as follows: 17 (k) Assistance for regional partnership proposals, as provided in subdivision 12 of section 3154 of the public authorities law[.]; AND 18 19 LOANS, LOAN GUARANTEES, INTEREST SUBSIDIES AND GRANTS TO SMALL (L) BUSINESSES, MUNICIPALITIES, NOT-FOR-PROFIT CORPORATIONS OR OTHER ORGAN-20 21 IZATIONS FOR THE PURPOSE OF PREVENTING CRIMES AGAINST SMALL BUSINESSES 22 OR ON THE PREMISES OR IN THE VICINITY OF SMALL BUSINESSES, INCLUDING INITIATING OR MAINTAINING BUSINESS WATCH PROGRAMS, 23 ACTIVITIES AS SUCH 24 INSTALLATION OF LIGHTING, SECURITY EQUIPMENT AND OTHER PHYSICAL IMPROVE-25 MENTS TO PREVENT OR DETER CRIMINAL ACTIVITIES, AND THE DEVELOPMENT AND DISSEMINATION OF INFORMATION TO OWNERS, OPERATORS AND EMPLOYEES OF SMALL 26 27 BUSINESSES ON EFFECTIVE CRIME PREVENTION STRATEGIES. PREFERENCE IN 28 AWARDING ASSISTANCE PURSUANT TO THIS PARAGRAPH SHALL BE GIVEN TΟ PROJECTS THAT WILL BENEFIT DISTRESSED AREAS OR OTHER AREAS WITH A DEMON-29 STRATED NEED BASED ON CRIME STATISTICS, PROJECTS THAT PROVIDE A LOCAL OR 30 PRIVATE-SECTOR MATCH, AND PROJECTS THAT DEMONSTRATE A LIKELIHOOD OF 31 32 POSITIVE IMPACT ON CRIME PREVENTION. THE DIVISION OF CRIMINAL JUSTICE PROVIDE ASSISTANCE IN THE DEVELOPMENT OF THE PROGRAM OF 33 SERVICES SHALL SMALL BUSINESS CRIME PREVENTION ASSISTANCE. 34 35 S 3. Section 837 of the executive law is amended by adding a new 36 subdivision 19 to read as follows: 37 19. PROVIDE ADVICE AND ASSISTANCE TO THE DIVISION FOR SMALL BUSINESS 38 IN DEVELOPING AND OPERATING A PROGRAM OF SMALL BUSINESS CRIME PREVENTION SERVICES PURSUANT TO SECTION ONE HUNDRED 39 THIRTY-NINE OF THE ECONOMIC 40 DEVELOPMENT LAW, AND PROVIDE ADVICE AND ASSISTANCE TO THE URBAN DEVELOP-CORPORATION THE DEVELOPMENT OF THE PROGRAM OF SMALL BUSINESS 41 MENT IN CRIME PREVENTION ASSISTANCE PURSUANT TO PARAGRAPH (L) OF SUBDIVISION ONE 42 43 OF SECTION SIXTEEN-M OF SECTION ONE OF CHAPTER ONE HUNDRED SEVENTY-FOUR 44 OF THE LAWS OF NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-EIGHT. 45 4.
