AN ACT to amend the education law, in relation to a change in circumstance of income and providing for the repeal of such provisions upon expiration thereof

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. Subdivision 5 of section 663 of the education law is 2 amended by adding a new paragraph (c) to read as follows:

- (C) WHEN MAKING ADJUSTMENTS TO INCOME FOR CHANGE IN CIRCUMSTANCE, THE PURSUANT TO RULES AND REGULATIONS, CORPORATION SHALL, INCLUDE THE FOLLOWING AS CAUSES FOR CHANGE IN STATUS OF THE APPLICANT: (I) CATASTROPHIC ILLNESS OF THE APPLICANT; AND (II) THE APPLICANT OR THE
- 6 CATASTROPHIC ILLNESS OF THE APPLICANT; AND (II) THE APPLICANT OR THE 7 SPOUSE OF THE APPLICANT BEING CALLED TO ACTIVE MILITARY DUTY.
- 8 S 2. This act shall take effect immediately and shall expire and be 9 deemed repealed June 30, 2010.
