AN ACT to amend the executive law, in relation to authorizing the division of criminal justice services to release criminal history record information to certain persons employed by the administration for children's services in the city of New York

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. Section 837 of the executive law is amended by adding a new
2 subdivision 19 to read as follows:
3 19. NOTWITHSTANDING ANY OTHER LAW, RULE OR REGULATION TO THE CONTRARY,
4 SUPPLY UPON REQUEST, AND IN ACCORDANCE WITH RULES AND REGULATIONS TO BE
5 PROMULGATED BY THE COMMISSIONER, CRIMINAL HISTORY RECORD INFORMATION OF
6 ADULTS LIVING IN HOUSEHOLDS INVOLVED IN A CHILD ABUSE ALLEGATION IN THE
7 CITY OF NEW YORK, TO CASEWORKERS EMPLOYED BY THE ADMINISTRATION FOR
8 CHILDREN'S SERVICES IN THE CITY OF NEW YORK.
9 S 2. This act shall take effect on the ninetieth day after it shall
10 have become a law; provided that the commissioner of the division of
11 criminal justice services is immediately authorized and directed to
12 promulgate, amend and/or repeal any rules and regulations necessary to
13 implement the provisions of this act on its effective date.
