AN ACT to amend the public service law, in relation to electrical gener-  
ating facilities

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEM-  
BLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. Section 66 of the public service law is amended by adding a  
2 new subdivision 29 to read as follows:  
3 29. (A) THE COMMISSION SHALL REQUIRE THAT ANY ELECTRICAL GENERATING  
4 FACILITY LOCATED WITHIN THE CITY OF NEW YORK, THAT WAS CONSTRUCTED  
5 BETWEEN JANUARY FIRST, TWO THOUSAND ONE AND DECEMBER THIRTY-FIRST, TWO  
6 THOUSAND ONE AND THAT LIES WITHIN FIVE HUNDRED FEET OF A RESIDENCE SHALL  
7 NOT BE PERMITTED TO OPERATE OR GENERATE ELECTRICITY UNLESS THE DEMAND  
8 FOR ELECTRICAL CAPACITY EXCEEDS THE DAILY FORECAST FOR THE CITY OF NEW  
9 YORK AS DETERMINED BY THE COMMISSION THE DAY BEFORE THE DAY OF USAGE.  
10 (B) THE COMMISSION SHALL REQUIRE THAT THE POWER AUTHORITY OF THE STATE  
11 OF NEW YORK PRODUCE A PLAN WITHIN SIX MONTHS FROM THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF  
12 THIS SUBDIVISION TO CEASE OPERATION OF ANY ELECTRICAL GENERATING FACILI-  
13 TY LOCATED WITHIN THE CITY OF NEW YORK, THAT WAS CONSTRUCTED BETWEEN  
14 JANUARY FIRST, TWO THOUSAND ONE AND DECEMBER THIRTY-FIRST, TWO THOUSAND  
15 ONE, AND THAT IS LOCATED WITHIN FIVE HUNDRED FEET OF A RESIDENCE, BY  
16 DECEMBER THIRTY-FIRST, TWO THOUSAND ELEVEN.  
17 S 2. This act shall take effect on the ninetieth day after it shall  
18 have become a law.
