Introduced by M. of A. PERRY -- read once and referred to the Committee on Environmental Conservation

AN ACT to amend the environmental conservation law, in relation to prohibiting the establishment or conversion of medical waste treatment, storage, transfer or disposal facilities within one mile of any residential area, prohibiting the issuance of permits to such facilities, and providing for the annual review of permits issued to previously-existing medical waste treatment, storage, transfer or disposal facilities located within one mile of any residential area

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. Section 27-1517 of the environmental conservation law is
2 amended by adding a new subdivision 4 to read as follows:
3 4. A. NOTWITHSTANDING ANY PROVISION OF LAW TO THE CONTRARY, ON OR
4 AFTER JANUARY FIRST, TWO THOUSAND TEN: (I) NO FACILITY PROVIDING FOR THE
5 STORAGE, TRANSPORTATION, TREATMENT OR DISPOSAL OF REGULATED MEDICAL
6 WASTE SHALL BE CONSTRUCTED WITHIN ONE MILE OF A RESIDENTIAL AREA LOCATED
7 WITHIN THE STATE; AND
8 (II) NO EXISTING FACILITY LOCATED WITHIN ONE MILE OF A RESIDENTIAL
9 AREA SHALL BE CONVERTED TO A FACILITY PROVIDING FOR THE STORAGE, TRAN-
10 PORTATION, TREATMENT OR DISPOSAL OF REGULATED MEDICAL WASTE.
11 B. NO PERMIT AUTHORIZING THE STORAGE, TRANSPORTATION, TREATMENT OR
12 DISPOSAL OF REGULATED MEDICAL WASTE SHALL BE ISSUED TO ANY FACILITY
13 DESCRIBED IN PARAGRAPH A OF THIS SUBDIVISION BY THE DEPARTMENT OR BY ANY
14 REGIONAL, DISTRICT OR COUNTY OFFICES OF THE STATE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH,
15 OR LOCAL HEALTH DEPARTMENT TO WHICH THE DEPARTMENT HAS DELEGATED RESPON-
16 SIBILITY TO ISSUE OR REVIEW PERMITS.
17 C. (I) ALL PERMITS FOR WHICH CONDITIONAL OR FINAL APPROVAL HAS BEEN
18 GRANTED OR WHICH HAVE BEEN ISSUED TO FACILITIES PROVIDING FOR THE STOR-
19 AGE, TRANSPORTATION, TREATMENT OR DISPOSAL OF REGULATED MEDICAL WASTE
20 AND LOCATED WITHIN ONE MILE OF A RESIDENTIAL AREA PRIOR TO THE EFFECTIVE

1 DATE OF THIS SECTION SHALL BE SUBJECT TO ANNUAL REVIEW BY THE DEPARTMENT
2 OR BY ANY REGIONAL, DISTRICT OR COUNTY OFFICES OF THE STATE DEPARTMENT
3 OF HEALTH, OR LOCAL HEALTH DEPARTMENT TO WHICH THE DEPARTMENT HAS DELEG-
4 ATED RESPONSIBILITY TO ISSUE OR REVIEW PERMITS. ANY PERMIT, RENEWAL
5 PERMIT OR MODIFIED PERMIT ISSUED FOLLOWING SUCH REVIEW SHALL BE VALID
6 FOR A PERIOD NOT TO EXCEED ONE YEAR.

7 (II) THE COMMISSIONER MAY, CONSISTENT WITH ARTICLES TWENTY-THREE AND
8 TWENTY-THREE-A OF THE CORRECTION LAW, AND THE PROVISIONS OF SECTION
9 70-0115 OF THIS CHAPTER, DENY, SUSPEND, REVOKE OR MODIFY ANY PERMIT,
10 RENEWAL OR MODIFICATION THERETO FOR THE STORAGE, TRANSPORTATION, TREAT-
11 MENT OR DISPOSAL OF REGULATED MEDICAL WASTE, UPON A WRITTEN DETERMI-
12 NATION THAT SUCH ACTION IS REQUIRED TO PROTECT THE PUBLIC HEALTH AND
13 SAFETY AND THAT ANY OF THE PROVISIONS OF PARAGRAPHS A, B, C OR D OF
14 SUBDIVISION ONE OF THIS SECTION APPLY.

15 D. THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SUBDIVISION SHALL NOT APPLY TO HOSPITALS AND
16 OTHER FACILITIES WHICH PERFORM ON-SITE TREATMENT AND DISPOSAL OF REGU-
17 LATED MEDICAL WASTE.

18 E. AS USED IN THIS SUBDIVISION, "RESIDENTIAL AREA" MEANS ANY AREA
19 ZONED FOR RESIDENTIAL USE, REGARDLESS OF WHETHER SUCH AREA IS ALSO ZONED
20 FOR OTHER USE.

21 F. THE COMMISSIONER IS AUTHORIZED TO PROMULGATE RULES AND REGULATIONS
22 AS HE OR SHE DEEMS NECESSARY TO IMPLEMENT THE PROVISIONS OF THIS
23 SECTION.

24 S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
