AN ACT to amend the social services law, in relation to residential services for victims of domestic violence

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. Section 459-b of the social services law, as added by chap-2 ter 169 of the laws of 1994, is amended to read as follows:

- S 459-b. Residential services for victims of domestic violence. In accordance with section one hundred thirty-one-u of this chapter and the regulations of the [department] OFFICE OF CHILDREN AND FAMILY SERVICES, a social services district shall offer and provide necessary and available emergency shelter and services at a residential program for victims of domestic violence to a victim of domestic violence who was residing in the social services district at the time of the alleged domestic violence whether or not such victim is eligible for public assistance; PROVIDED, HOWEVER, THAT SUCH LAW, RULES AND REGULATIONS SHALL NOT LIMIT THE MAXIMUM LENGTH OF STAY OF VICTIMS AT SUCH RESIDENTIAL PROGRAMS TO
