AN ACT to amend the state law, in relation to a state slogan

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 Section 1. The state law is amended by adding a new section 88 to read 2 as follows:
- 3 S 88. STATE SLOGAN. "I LOVE NEW YORK" SHALL BE THE OFFICIAL STATE 4 SLOGAN.
- 5 S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
