AN ACT requiring the office of parks, recreation and historic preservation to take a parcel of land through the eminent domain procedure

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. The legislature hereby finds that it is necessary for a
2 public purpose to procure certain property within the city of New York.
3 To that extent, the commissioner of the office of parks, recreation and
4 historic preservation is hereby directed to take, through the use of the
5 eminent domain procedure as established under the eminent domain procedure law,
6 the parcel located between North 12th Street and North 14th
7 Street and between the East River Waterfront and Kent Street, commonly
8 known as 1 North 12th Street, Brooklyn. Such parcel is designated on the
9 tax maps of such borough as block 2277, lot 1 and constitutes approximately
10 8.4 acres.
11 S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
