AN ACT to authorize approval of a certain transportation contract of the Whitehall central school district

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. All acts done and proceedings heretofore had and taken or
2 caused to be had and taken by the Whitehall central school district and
3 by all officers, employees and agents of such school district relating
4 to or in connection with transportation contract number C260112 for the
5 2007-2008 school year, which provided transportation to and from the New
6 York state school for the blind in Batavia, and all acts incidental
7 thereto are hereby legalized, validated, ratified and confirmed,
8 notwithstanding any failure to comply with the contract award, award,
9 approval and filing provisions of the education law, the general municipal law, any other law or any other statutory authority, rule or regulation, other than those filing provisions defined in paragraph a of subdivision 5 of section 3604 of the education law, in relation to any omission, error, defect, irregularity or illegality in such proceedings had or taken.

15 S 2. The education department is hereby directed to consider the
16 aforementioned contract for transportation aid as valid and proper obligations of the Whitehall central school district.

18 S 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
