AN ACT to amend the education law, in relation to the certification of
pharmacy technicians

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEM-
BLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. The education law is amended by adding a new section 6805-a
2 to read as follows:
3 S 6805-A. REQUIREMENTS FOR CERTIFICATION AS A PHARMACY TECHNICIAN. 1.
4 TO QUALIFY TO BE A PHARMACY TECHNICIAN, AN APPLICANT SHALL FULFILL THE
5 FOLLOWING REQUIREMENTS:
6 A. APPLICATION: FILE AN APPLICATION WITH THE DEPARTMENT;
7 B. EDUCATION: HAVE RECEIVED AN EDUCATION, INCLUDING: (I) HIGH SCHOOL
8 GRADUATION OR A GENERAL EQUIVALENCY DIPLOMA (GED); AND (II) SUCCESSFUL
9 COMPLETION OF A BOARD CERTIFICATION PROGRAM;
10 C. EXPERIENCE: HAVE EXPERIENCE SATISFACTORY TO THE BOARD AND IN
11 ACCORDANCE WITH THE COMMISSIONER'S REGULATIONS;
12 D. EXAMINATION: PASS AN EXAMINATION SATISFACTORY TO THE BOARD AND IN
13 ACCORDANCE WITH THE COMMISSIONER'S REGULATIONS;
14 E. AGE: BE AT LEAST EIGHTEEN YEARS OF AGE; AND
15 F. CHARACTER: BE OF GOOD MORAL CHARACTER AS DETERMINED BY THE DEPART-
16 MENT INCLUDING HAVING NO FELONY OR DRUG RELATED CONVICTIONS.
17 2. NO PERSON SHALL ACT AS A PHARMACY TECHNICIAN UNLESS REGISTERED BY
18 THE BOARD.
19 3. FOR THE PURPOSES OF THIS SECTION:
20 A. "BOARD" SHALL MEAN THE STATE BOARD OF PHARMACY;
21 B. "PHARMACY TECHNICIAN" SHALL MEAN AN INDIVIDUAL DELEGATED DUTIES,
22 TASKS OR FUNCTIONS BY A LICENSED PHARMACIST TO FULFILL THEIR DUTY OF
23 PROVIDING HEALTH CARE PRODUCTS TO PATIENTS; AND

1 C. "CERTIFIED PHARMACY TECHNICIAN" SHALL MEAN AN INDIVIDUAL WHO HAS
2 SUCCESSFULLY FULFILLED THE REQUIREMENTS TO OBTAIN PHARMACY TECHNICIAN
3 CERTIFICATION PURSUANT TO SUBDIVISION ONE OF THIS SECTION.

4 S 2. This act shall take effect on the first of January next succeed-
5 ing the date on which it shall have become a law; provided, however,
6 that effective immediately, the addition, amendment and/or repeal of any
7 rule or regulation necessary for the implementation of the provisions of
8 this act on its effective date is authorized and directed to be made and
9 completed on or before such effective date.
