AN ACT to amend the education law, in relation to an after-school challenge program

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEM-BLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The education law is amended by adding a new section 319 to read as follows:

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- S 319. AFTER-SCHOOL CHALLENGE PROGRAM. 1. THERE IS HEREBY ESTABLISHED JURISDICTION OF THE COMMISSIONER AN AFTER-SCHOOL CHALLENGE PROGRAM TO PROVIDE SCHOOLS WITH MATCHING FUNDS FOR RESOURCES RAISED PRIVATE DONATIONS TO SUPPORT AFTER-SCHOOL PROGRAMS. EACH DISTRICT SHALL BE ELIGIBLE TO RECEIVE A MAXIMUM OF FIFTY THOUSAND DOLLARS ANNUALLY MATCHING FUNDS FROM THE STATE BEGINNING WITH THE TWO THOUSAND THREE--TWO THOUSAND FOUR SCHOOL YEAR. PROGRAMS UNDER THIS SECTION SHALL PROVIDE AFTER-SCHOOL CARE FOR STUDENTS AFFORDABLE, LOW-COST IN GRADES ONE RUN AFTER SCHOOL UNTIL AT LEAST SIX O'CLOCK P.M. THROUGH EIGHT THAT PRIORITY IN AWARDING GRANTS SHALL BE GIVEN TO CURRICULUM BASED EDUCATION PROGRAMS OR COMMUNITY SERVICE PROGRAMS. THE COMMISSIONER SHALL ESTABLISH ADDITIONAL CRITERIA FOR THE AWARDING OF CHALLENGE GRANTS PROVIDED FOR IN THIS SECTION.
- 2. THE MATCHING CONTRIBUTIONS RAISED BY A SCHOOL DISTRICT MUST BE FROM SOURCES OTHER THAN STATE APPROPRIATIONS OR FEDERAL FUNDS. CONTRIBUTIONS SHALL COME FROM CONTRIBUTIONS, PLEDGED FOR THE PURPOSES SPECIFIED IN THIS SECTION OR UNPLEDGED, AND ACCRUED INVESTMENT **EARNINGS** JANUARY FIRST, TWO THOUSAND TEN. DONATIONS MAY BE MADE AFTER FINANCIAL OR IN-KIND CONTRIBUTIONS RECEIVED FROM INDIVIDUALS AND BUSI-21 COMMUNITY. ONCE THE NECESSARY LEVEL OF MATCHING 22 NESSES THROUGHOUT $_{

- 3 3. THE COMMISSIONER SHALL REPORT ON THE SUCCESS OF THE PROGRAM ON OR 4 BEFORE JULY FIRST, TWO THOUSAND TWELVE.
- S 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2010. The commissioner of education is authorized and directed to promulgate any rules or regulations necessary for the implementation of this act on or before such effective date.
