AN ACT to authorize the Levittown union free school district to transfer certain monies from reserve funds to the general fund for the purpose of real property tax reduction; and providing for the repeal of such provisions upon expiration thereof

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, rule or regulation to the contrary, the Levittown union free school district is
2 authorized to transfer to the general fund of such school district, for
3 the sole purpose of real property tax reduction, not more than twenty
4 million dollars (\$20,000,000) from the following reserve funds: up to
5 fifteen million eight hundred thousand dollars (\$15,800,000) from the
6 employee benefit accrued liability reserve fund, and up to four million
7 two hundred thousand dollars (\$4,200,000) from the retirement reserve
8 fund.

10 S 2. This act shall take effect immediately and shall expire and be
11 deemed repealed July 1, 2011.
