AN ACT to amend the state finance law, in relation to changing the state fiscal year from the first of April to the first of June

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. Section 3 of the state finance law, as added by chapter 1 2 of the laws of 1943 and as separately renumbered by chapters 405 and 957 3 of the laws of 1981, is amended to read as follows:

Fiscal year. 4 S 3. 1. The current fiscal year of the state which commenced with the first day of [July, nineteen hundred forty-two] 5 6 THOUSAND NINE, is hereby [abridged] EXTENDED and shall end APRIL, TWO 7 with the thirty-first day of [March, nineteen hundred forty-three] MAY, THOUSAND TEN. For all purposes of determining annual increments of 8 TWO 9 state employees pursuant to the education law, the civil service law or 10 state law, and for all purposes whenever by law some act is to be other 11 performed or time is to be measured by the fiscal year of the state, the 12 current fiscal year, as so [abridged] EXTENDED, shall be deemed to be a 13 full year unless the context clearly requires a contrary construction.

after the first day of [April, nineteen hundred forty-three] 14 On and 15 JUNE, TWO THOUSAND TEN, the fiscal year of the state, for the purpose of budget, appropriations, receipts and disbursements of state moneys and 16 17 all other state affairs which are regulated in accordance with or based on fiscal years, including the fiscal affairs of all state departments, 18 commissions, boards, agencies, offices and institutions, shall begin 19 with the first day of [April] JUNE and end with the next following thir-20 21 ty-first day of [March] MAY.

22 2. All books and accounts in the offices of the comptroller and the 23 department of taxation and finance shall be kept by fiscal years. All 24 annual accounts required to be rendered to the comptroller or to such

1 department by any person shall be closed on the thirty-first day of 2 [March] MAY in each year, and be rendered as soon thereafter as practi-3 cable, if no time is specially prescribed by law.

4 3. Where any statute provides, in terms or effect, that any inventory or account, or a report relating in whole or in part to receipts and 5 6 disbursements of money, be made to the legislature or any state officer 7 annually, or for a year, by a department, commission, board, or officer 8 under the state government, such inventory or account, and such report 9 so far as it relates to such receipts and disbursements, shall be for 10 the preceding fiscal year, unless the calendar year be expressly 11 mentioned.

12 4. Existing provisions of other laws describing or referring to a fiscal year of the state as beginning [July] APRIL first and ending 13 14 [June thirtieth] MARCH THIRTY-FIRST, or making any requirement with 15 respect to such fiscal year, or referring to any year so beginning and 16 ending which applies to inventories or accounts in state matters, or to reports relating to state money or property, shall be deemed modified by 17 and be construed in connection with this section, and be deemed to refer 18 to a fiscal or to another year or period beginning and ending as [here-in] prescribed IN THIS SECTION for a fiscal year. 19 20

21 S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
