Introduced by M. of A. MILLER -- read once and referred to the Committee on Health

AN ACT to amend the public health law, in relation to exempting commuter colleges from the requirement of maintaining measles, mumps and rubella (MMR) and meningococcal meningitis records

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 Section 1. Subdivision 1 of section 2165 of the public health law is  
2 amended by adding a new paragraph e to read as follows:  
3 E. THE TERM "COMMUTER COLLEGE" MEANS ANY TWO-YEAR COMMUNITY COLLEGE  
4 NOT HAVING ANY STUDENT HOUSING.  
5 S 2. Section 2165 of the public health law is amended by adding a new  
6 subdivision 14 to read as follows:  
7 14. THIS SECTION SHALL NOT APPLY TO COMMUTER COLLEGES AS DEFINED IN  
8 SUBDIVISION ONE OF THIS SECTION.  
9 S 3. Subdivision 1 of section 2167 of the public health law is amended  
10 by adding a new paragraph d to read as follows:  
11 D. THE TERM "COMMUTER COLLEGE" MEANS ANY TWO-YEAR COMMUNITY COLLEGE  
12 NOT HAVING ANY STUDENT HOUSING.  
13 S 4. Section 2167 of the public health law is amended by adding a new  
14 subdivision 7 to read as follows:  
15 7. THIS SECTION SHALL NOT APPLY TO COMMUTER COLLEGES AS DEFINED IN  
16 SUBDIVISION ONE OF THIS SECTION.  
17 S 5. This act shall take effect immediately.
