AN ACT to amend the public authorities law, in relation to powers granted to municipalities concerning public utility services

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEM-BLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. Section 1020-h of the public authorities law, as added by chapter 517 of the laws of 1986, is amended by adding two new subdivisions 12 and 13 to read as follows:
- 12. NOTHING IN THIS TITLE SHALL BE CONSTRUED AS PREEMPTING, OR OTHER-THE RIGHTS OF ANY MUNICIPALITY LOCATED IN WHOLE OR IN WISE LIMITING, PART IN THE SERVICE AREA FROM EXERCISING ANY POWER OR AUTHORITY 7 TO IT BY ARTICLE FOURTEEN-A OF THE GENERAL MUNICIPAL LAW, INCLUDING THE RIGHT TO ACQUIRE FACILITIES THROUGH EMINENT DOMAIN AS SET FORTH 9 SUBDIVISION SIX OF SECTION THREE HUNDRED SIXTY OF THE GENERAL MUNICIPAL 10 LAW.
- 13. IN CONJUNCTION WITH THE EXERCISE OF THE POWER OF 11 EMINENT 12 SPECIFICALLY RESERVED TO MUNICIPALITIES LOCATED IN WHOLE OR IN PART IN 13 THE SERVICE AREA, THE LEGISLATIVE FINDINGS WITH RESPECT TO THE APPROPRI-ATE VALUATION OF LILCO'S PROPERTY, AS SET FORTH 14 ΙN PARAGRAPHS 15 THROUGH (M) OF SUBDIVISION ONE OF THIS SECTION, SHALL BE CONSIDERED BY THE COURT IN ESTABLISHING JUST COMPENSATION FOR ANY 16 PROPERTY 17 ANY SUCH MUNICIPALITY.
- S 2. This act shall take effect immediately. 18
