AN ACT making appropriations for the support of government

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. Legislative intent. The legislature hereby finds and
2 declares that the enactment of these appropriations provides sufficient
3 authority to the comptroller for the purpose of making payments for the
4 purposes described herein until such time as appropriation bills submit-
5 ted by the governor pursuant to article VII of the state constitution
6 for the support of government for the state fiscal year beginning April
7 1, 2009 are enacted.

8 S 2. The sum of twenty-five million three hundred sixty-six thousand
9 dollars (\$25,366,000), or so much thereof as shall be sufficient to
10 accomplish the purpose designated, is hereby appropriated and authorized
11 to be paid as hereinafter provided, to the public officers and for the
12 purposes specified, which amount shall be available for the state fiscal
13 year beginning April 1, 2009.

15 S 3. The sum of twenty-three million two hundred forty-five thousand
 16 dollars (\$23,245,000), or so much thereof as shall be sufficient to
 17 accomplish the purpose designated, is hereby appropriated out of any
 18 moneys in the general fund to the credit of the state purposes account
 19 not otherwise appropriated for the purpose of paying to the social secu-
 20 rity contribution fund, the state's share, as employer, of the payroll
 21 tax for the payroll scheduled to be paid on April 1, 2009, including
 22 liabilities incurred prior to April 1, 2009 23,245,000
 23 =====

24 S 4. The sum of twenty-five thousand dollars (\$25,000), or so much
 25 thereof as shall be sufficient to accomplish the purpose designated, is
 26 hereby appropriated out of any moneys in the general fund to the credit
 27 of the state purposes account not otherwise appropriated for payments to
 28 the teachers insurance and annuity association and college retirement
 29 equities fund associated with individuals working in the education
 30 department, the higher education services corporation, the division of
 31 veterans affairs and the state university of New York construction fund.
 32 Notwithstanding any other provisions of law to the contrary, the comp-
 33 troller is hereby authorized and directed to utilize this appropriation
 34 for the purpose of making scheduled teachers insurance and annuity asso-
 35 ciation and college retirement equities fund payments 25,000
 36 =====

37 S 5. The sum of two hundred ninety-five thousand dollars (\$295,000),
 38 or so much thereof as shall be sufficient to accomplish the purpose
 39 designated, is hereby appropriated to the olympic regional development
 40 authority out of any moneys in the general fund to the credit of the
 41 state purposes account not otherwise appropriated, for payment of staff
 42 salaries 295,000

44 S 6. No expenditure may be made from any appropriation in this act
 45 until a certificate of approval has been issued by the director of the
 46 budget and a copy of such certificate shall have been filed with the
 47 state comptroller, the chairman of the senate finance committee and the
 48 chairman of the assembly ways and means committee.

49 S 7. All expenditures and disbursements made against the appropri-
 50 ations in this act shall, upon final action by the legislature on appro-
 51 priation bills submitted by the governor pursuant to article VII of the

1 state constitution for the support of government for the state fiscal
2 year beginning April 1, 2009, be transferred by the comptroller as
3 expenditures and disbursements to such appropriations for all state
4 departments, agencies, the legislature and the judiciary, as applicable,
5 in amounts equal to the amounts charged against the appropriations in
6 this act for each such department, agency, the legislature and the judi-
7 ciary.

8 S 8. This act shall take effect immediately and shall be deemed to
9 have been in full force and effect on and after April 1, 2009; provided,
10 however, that upon the transfer of expenditures and disbursements by the
11 comptroller as provided in section seven of this act, the appropriations
12 made by this act and subject to such section shall be deemed repealed.
