AN ACT to amend the public service law, in relation to prohibiting certain additional charges for unlisted telephone numbers

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. The public service law is amended by adding a new section 2 92-g to read as follows:

S 92-G. TELEPHONE SERVICE; CHARGES. NO TELEPHONE CORPORATION OR PROVIDER OR ANY PERSON, FIRM OR CORPORATION ACTING AS AN AGENT OR REPRESENTATIVE OF A TELEPHONE CORPORATION OR PROVIDER SHALL IMPOSE ANY ADDITIONAL CHARGE FOR UNLISTED TELEPHONE NUMBERS OVER AND ABOVE THE CUSTOMARY CHARGES IMPOSED BY THAT TELEPHONE CORPORATION OR PROVIDER FOR LISTED TELEPHONE NUMBERS, NOR SHOULD ANY FEE BE ASSOCIATED WITH MAKING PRIVATE A TELEPHONE NUMBER THAT IS PUBLIC. IN CONSTRUING AND ENFORCING THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SECTION, THE ACT OF ANY PERSON, FIRM OR CORPORATION ACTING AS AN AGENT OR REPRESENTATIVE OF A TELEPHONE CORPORATION SHALL BE DEEMED TO BE THE ACT OF SUCH TELEPHONE CORPORATION.
