AN ACT to amend the state finance law, in relation to deposits on plans and specifications for contracts for public works

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. Subdivision 1 of section 143 of the state finance law, as
2 amended by chapter 43 of the laws of 1969, is amended to read as
3 follows:
4 1. Notwithstanding any inconsistent provision of any general or
5 special law, the board, division, department, bureau, agency, officer or
6 commission of the state charged with the duty of preparing plans and
7 specifications for and awarding or entering into contracts for the
8 performance of public work [shall] MAY require the payment of a fixed
9 sum of money, not exceeding one hundred dollars, for each copy of such
10 plans and specifications, by persons or corporations desiring a copy
11 thereof. Any person or corporation desiring a copy of such plans and
12 specifications and making the deposit required by this section shall be
13 furnished with one copy of the plans and specifications. NOTWITHSTANDING
14 THE ABOVE WHERE PAYMENT IS REQUIRED, IT SHALL BE WAIVED UPON REQUEST BY
15 MINORITY AND WOMEN-OWNED BUSINESS ENTERPRISES CERTIFIED PURSUANT TO
16 ARTICLE FIFTEEN-A OF THE EXECUTIVE LAW. SUCH PAYMENT MAY ALSO BE WAIVED
17 WHEN THE PLANS AND SPECIFICATIONS ARE MADE AVAILABLE AND OBTAINED ELEC-
18 TRONICALLY OR IN ANY NON-PAPER FORM FROM THE BOARD, DIVISION, DEPART-
19 MENT, BUREAU, AGENCY, OFFICER OR COMMISSION OF THE STATE.
20 S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
