AN ACT to authorize the Bolivar-Richburg central school district to repay certain excess state aid over a period of 3 years

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. Notwithstanding any provisions of law to the contrary,  
2 state aid payments in the amount of not more than three hundred eleven  
3 thousand nine hundred sixty-two dollars (\$311,962) made to the Bolivar-  
4 Richburg central school district in the 2004--2005 school year, which  
5 included excess payments of state aid of which the district has been  
6 notified, and for which a recovery must be made by the state through  
7 deduction of future aid payments, shall be reduced through aid  
8 deductions totaling such excess payments, by deducting one-third of such  
9 excess payments from the payments due to such school district and paya-  
10 ble in the month of June in the years 2009, 2010 and 2011; provided,  
11 however, there shall be no interest penalty assessed against such  
12 district or collected by the state, and provided further that, notwith-  
13 standing any other provisions of this act, any pending payment of moneys  
14 due to such district as a prior year adjustment payable pursuant to  
15 paragraph c of subdivision 5 of section 3604 of the education law for  
16 aid claims that had been previously paid in excess as current year aid  
17 payments and for which recovery of excess payments is to be made pursu-  
18 ant to this section, shall be reduced at the time of actual payment by  
19 any remaining unrecovered balance of such excess payments, and the  
20 remaining scheduled deductions of such excess payments pursuant to this  
21 section shall be reduced by the commissioner of education to reflect the  
22 amount so recovered.

23 S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
