AN ACT to amend chapter 519 of the laws of 1999, amending the alcoholic beverage control law and the public health law relating to the sale of alcohol and tobacco products to minors, in relation to extending the provisions of such chapter

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. Section 4 of chapter 519 of the laws of 1999 amending the
2 alcoholic beverage control law and the public health law relating to the
3 sale of alcohol and tobacco products to minors, as amended by section 45
4 of part B of chapter 58 of the laws of 2009, is amended to read as
5 follows:
6 S 4. This act shall take effect September 1, 1999, AND SHALL REMAIN IN
7 FULL FORCE AND EFFECT UNTIL JANUARY 1, 2012 WHEN UPON SUCH DATE THE
8 PROVISIONS OF THIS ACT SHALL EXPIRE AND BE DEEMED REPEALED; provided,
9 however, the state liquor authority, state department of motor vehicles
10 and state department of health shall promulgate rules and regulations
11 necessary to implement the provisions of this act on or before such
12 date; PROVIDED FURTHER THAT THE PROVISIONS OF THIS ACT SHALL APPLY AFTER
13 SUCH EXPIRATION DATE TO ANY PROCEEDING PURSUANT TO THE ALCOHOLIC BEVER-
14 AGE CONTROL LAW OR PUBLIC HEALTH LAW TO INVOKE OR ENFORCE THE PROVISIONS
15 OF THIS ACT WHICH WERE COMMENCED PRIOR TO SUCH EXPIRATION DATE; and
16 provided, further however, that the amendments to section 65-b of the
17 alcoholic beverage control law made by section two of this act shall not
18 affect the repeal of such section and shall be deemed repealed there-
19 with.
20 S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
