Introduced by M. of A. TITONE -- read once and referred to the Committee on Transportation

AN ACT to amend the vehicle and traffic law, in relation to allowing "Safe-Teen-NY Driver" stickers on license plates of vehicles driven by persons under the age of eighteen

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEM-BLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 507 of the vehicle and traffic law is amended by adding a new subdivision 6 to read as follows:
- 6. DISPLAY OF SAFE-TEEN-NY DRIVER STICKER. ANY DRIVER WHO IS THE AGE OF EIGHTEEN AND HOLDS A LEARNER'S PERMIT, A LIMITED CLASS DJ OR LIMITED CLASS MJ LICENSE, OR A CLASS DJ OR CLASS MJ LICENSE, MAY DISPLAY A SAFE-TEEN-NY DRIVER STICKER ON OR NEAR THE LICENSE PLATE OF EACH VEHI-CLE DRIVEN BY SUCH INDIVIDUAL. THE PARENTS AND LEGAL GUARDIANS DRIVERS MAY ALSO DISPLAY A SAFE-TEEN-NY DRIVER STICKER. THE STICKER SHALL BE YELLOW IN COLOR, AND BEAR THE WORDS "SAFE-TEEN-NY DRIVER". DEPARTMENT SHALL DEVELOP AND MAINTAIN SUCH STICKERS FOR ISSUANCE UPON 10 REQUEST PURSUANT TO THIS SUBDIVISION. 11

S 2.
