Introduced by M. of A. FITZPATRICK -- read once and referred to the Committee on Real Property Taxation

AN ACT to authorize the Holy Cross Roman Catholic Church to retroactively apply for a real property tax exemption for certain property in the town of Smithtown, county of Suffolk

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Notwithstanding any other provision of law to the contrary, 1 the assessor of the town of Smithtown is hereby authorized to accept 2 3 from the Holy Cross Roman Catholic Church an application or renewal 4 application for exemption from real property taxes pursuant to section 5 420-a of the real property tax law for the 2005-2006 assessment rolls, 6 for the parcel owned by such not-for-profit church which is located at 85 Nichols Road, village of Nesconset in the town of Smithtown, 7 county 8 of Suffolk, otherwise known as Suffolk county tax map school district 8, section 169, block 001, lots 009.001 and 009.002. If accepted, the 9 application or renewal application shall be reviewed as if it had been 10 received on or before the taxable status date established for such 11 12 rolls.

13 If satisfied that such not-for-profit organization would otherwise be entitled to such exemption if such not-for-profit organization had filed 14 application or renewal application for exemption by the appropriate 15 an 16 taxable status date, the assessor, upon approval by the Smithtown town 17 board, may make appropriate correction to the subject rolls. If such 18 exemption is granted and such organization, therefore, shall have paid any tax with respect to the subject rolls, the applicable governing body 19 or tax department may, in its sole discretion, provide for the refund of 20 those taxes paid and cancel those taxes, fines, penalties, liens, or 21 22 interest remaining unpaid.
