AN ACT in relation to authorizing a study on the feasibility of retaining the New York State Veterans Home at Oxford, New York

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, there is hereby
2 established a moratorium on the demolition, destruction or razing of the
3 New York State Veterans Home at Oxford, New York. The duration of such
4 moratorium shall be for a period of one year beginning on the effective
5 date of this act, and may be renewed for an additional year by act of
6 the legislature at the end of such period. During the period of such
7 moratorium, the department of health is authorized to conduct a study on
8 the feasibility of retaining such veterans home. Such study shall exam-
9 ine potential uses for such veterans home. Such potential uses shall
10 include, but shall not be limited to, an extended care facility for
11 veterans, a veterans' domiciliary, a veterans' clinic, office space for
12 state agencies, and a reserve medical facility to be used in the event
13 of a natural disaster or terrorist attack. The department of health
14 shall report its findings to the governor and the legislature no later
15 than thirty days prior to the termination of the moratorium established
16 pursuant to this act.
17 S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
