AN ACT to amend chapter 420 of the laws of 2002 amending the education law relating to the profession of social work and chapter 676 of the laws of 2002 amending the education law relating to defining the practice of psychology, in relation to making certain provisions of law relating to social work and mental health practitioners permanent

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. Section 9 of chapter 420 of the laws of 2002, amending the
2 education law relating to the profession of social work, as amended by
3 section 1 of part II of chapter 57 of the laws of 2009, is amended to
4 read as follows:
5 S 9. Nothing in this act shall prohibit or limit the activities or
6 services on the part of any person in the employ of a program or service
7 operated, regulated, funded, or approved by the department of mental
8 hygiene or the office of children and family services, or a local
9 governmental unit as that term is defined in article 41 of the mental
10 hygiene law or a social services district as defined in section 61 of
11 the social services law, provided, however, this section shall not
12 authorize the use of any title authorized pursuant to article 154 of the
13 education law[, except that this section shall be deemed repealed on
14 June 1, 2010].
15 S 2. Section 17-a of chapter 676 of the laws of 2002, amending the
16 education law relating to defining the practice of psychology, as
17 amended by section 2 of part II of chapter 57 of the laws of 2009, is
18 amended to read as follows:
19 S 17-a. Nothing in this act shall prohibit or limit the activities or
20 services on the part of any person in the employ of a program or service
21 operated, regulated, funded, or approved by the department of mental
22 hygiene or the office of children and family services, or a local

1 governmental unit as that term is defined in article 41 of the mental
2 hygiene law or a social services district as defined in section 61 of

6 except that this section shall be deemed repealed on June 1, 2010].
7 S 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
