AN ACT to amend the insurance law, in relation to funding of the Brooklyn healthworks pilot program and upstate healthworks pilot program

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. Subsection (t) of section 4327 of the insurance law, as
2 added by chapter 441 of the laws of 2006, is amended to read as follows:
3 (t) Brooklyn healthworks pilot program and upstate healthworks pilot
4 program. Commencing on July first, two thousand six, the superintendent
5 shall access funding from the small employer stop loss fund and the
6 qualifying individual stop loss fund for the purpose of support and
7 expansion of the existing pilot program Brooklyn healthworks approved by
8 the superintendent and for the establishment and operation of a pilot
9 program to be located in upstate New York. For the purpose of this
10 subsection, [in no event shall] the amount of funding available SHALL
11 NOT exceed [two] FOUR percent of the annual funding amounts for the
12 small employer stop loss fund and the qualifying individual stop loss
13 fund.
14 S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
