AN ACT to amend the highway law, in relation to drug free zone signs near public libraries

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. The highway law is amended by adding a new section 318 to  
2 read as follows:

3 S 318. DRUG FREE LIBRARY ZONE SIGNS. ANY POLITICAL SUBDIVISION OF THE  
4 STATE HAVING JURISDICTION OVER ANY HIGHWAY FRONTING ANY PUBLIC LIBRARY,  
5 AS DEFINED IN SUBDIVISION TWO OF SECTION TWO HUNDRED FIFTY-THREE OF THE  
6 EDUCATION LAW, MAY, UPON THE REQUEST OF THE APPROPRIATE LIBRARY AUTHORITY,  
7 PLACE, CAUSE TO BE PLACED, OR PERMIT TO BE PLACED WITHIN THE RIGHT  
8 OF WAY OF SUCH HIGHWAY, SIGNS INDICATING A DRUG FREE ZONE.

9 S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
