AN ACT to amend the agriculture and markets law, in relation to the definition of "agricultural commodity"

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. Subdivision 1 of section 293 of the agriculture and markets
2 law, as amended by chapter 234 of the laws of 1995, is amended to read
3 as follows:
4 (1) "Agricultural commodity" means any and all agricultural, horticultural,
5 vineyard products, corn for grain, oats, soybeans, barley, wheat,
6 poultry or poultry products, bees, maple [syrup] SAP AND PURE MAPLE
7 PRODUCTS PRODUCED THEREFROM, christmas trees, livestock, including
8 swine, and honey, sold in the state either in their natural state or as
9 processed by the producer thereof but does not include milk, timber or
10 timber products, other than christmas trees, all hay, rye and legumes
11 except for soybeans.
12 S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
