- AN ACT to amend the administrative code of the city of New York, in relation to clearly marking certain pedestrian crosswalks in any city having a population of one million or more persons

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. The administrative code of the city of New York is amended 2 by adding a new section 19-112.1 to read as follows:

3 S 19-112.1 MARKING CERTAIN PEDESTRIAN CROSSWALKS AND RAMPS. ALL PEDES-4 TRIAN CROSSWALKS AND RAMPS, NOT LOCATED AT STREET INTERSECTIONS, SHALL 5 BE CLEARLY MARKED AND PAINTED. THIS PROVISION SHALL APPLY TO BOTH NEW 6 AND RECONSTRUCTED CROSSWALKS AND RAMPS.

7 S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
