AN ACT to amend the tax law, in relation to the timing of distribution of mortgage recording tax revenues by counties

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Subdivision 3 of section 261 of the tax law, as amended by chapter 287 of the laws of 2006, is amended to read as follows:

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On or before the tenth day of each month the recording officer of each county shall pay over to the county treasurer of said county, and in the counties of New York, Kings, Queens, Richmond and Bronx to the commissioner of finance of the city of New York for credit to the general fund of such city, the balance of the moneys received during preceding month upon account of taxes paid to him or her as herein prescribed, after deducting the necessary expenses of his or her office provided in section two hundred sixty-two of this article, except taxes paid upon mortgages which under the provisions of section hundred sixty of this article are first to be apportioned by the commissioner, which taxes and money shall be paid over by the commissioner of finance of the city of New York as provided by the determination of the In each county not within the city of New York, the whole of the net amount of such balance, after the deduction by the county the necessary expenses of his or her office provided in of section two hundred sixty-two of this article, shall be held by him or and shall be allocated to the tax districts of the county according to the location of the real property covered by the respective mortgages upon which the tax was collected. [The recording officer and county treasurer shall prepare a joint semi-annual report on or before May fifteenth and on or before November fifteenth in each year showing amounts to be credited to each tax district of the county of the moneys collected under this article during the preceding periods of six months each which ended respectively on March thirty-first and September thirtieth. Such report shall be made in duplicate in accordance with the rules and regulations of the commissioner and filed with the clerk of

THE governing board of the county[, county may instead] SHALL prepare and file [such] a joint report and 11 12 make such payments on EITHER a monthly or quarterly basis. 13 county elects to make monthly payments, the recording officer and county 14 treasurer shall prepare a joint report on or before the fifteenth day of 15 each month showing the amounts to be credited to each tax district of 16 the county and the moneys collected under this article for the month preceding the most recently concluded month, and the board of supervi-17 18 sors shall issue its warrant for payment on or before the fifteenth day the following month. Where the county elects to make quarterly 19 payments, the recording officer and county treasurer shall prepare such 20 21 joint report on or before the fifteenth day of May, August, November, and February, showing the amounts to be credited to each tax district of 22 the county of moneys collected under this article for the preceding 23 three-month period ending March thirty-first, June thirtieth, September 24 25 thirtieth, and December thirty-first, respectively and the board of 26 supervisors shall issue its warrant for payment on or before the fifteenth day of June, September, December, and March, respectively. The 27 warrant shall direct payment to the city treasurer of the amount due the 28 29 city, to the town supervisor of the amount due the town, and to the village treasurer of the amount to which the village shall be entitled. 30 31 Mortgage tax moneys allotted to cities, towns and villages shall be 32 applied to the payment of the general expenses thereof. The commissioner 33 shall prescribe the method of adjustment and correction of errors here-34 tofore or hereafter made in the distribution of moneys collected under 35
