AN ACT to amend the executive law, in relation to designating Mirror Lake and Lake Placid as inland waterways for purposes of waterfront revitalization

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Paragraph (a) of subdivision 4 of section 911 of the executive law, as separately amended by chapters 185, 186 and 363 of the laws of 2008, is amended to read as follows:

(a) the state's major inland lakes consisting of lakes Big Tupper, Black, Canandaigua, Cayuga, Champlain, Chautauqua, Conesus, Cranberry, George, Great Sacandaga, Honoeye, Indian, Keuka, Long, MIRROR, Oneida, Onondaga, Otisco, Otsego, Owasco, PLACID, Raquette, Sacandaga, Saratoga, Schroon, Seneca, Skaneateles and Saranac, and the Fulton chain of lakes; S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
