- AN ACT to amend the public health law, in relation to requiring public toilet facilities in restaurants with a seating capacity of ten or more

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. Subdivisions 1 and 2 of section 1352-a of the public health 2 law, as added by chapter 774 of the laws of 1977, are amended to read as 3 follows:

4 A person or corporation operating an establishment with a seating 1. 5 capacity of [twenty] TEN or more wherein food is sold for consumption on б the premises shall provide appropriately identified and maintained 7 public toilet facilities except that if there exists alternate available 8 facilities in the same building wherein such establishment is located, 9 suitable public notice of such alternate facility shall suffice for 10 purposes of this [act] SECTION.

12 [The] IN CITIES WITH A POPULATION OF ONE MILLION OR MORE, THE 12 provisions of subdivision one of this section shall [not] apply to 13 establishments [in operation on] NEWLY OPENED FOR BUSINESS ON AND AFTER 14 the effective date of this [act] SECTION.

15 S 2. This act shall take effect on the three hundred sixty-fifth day 16 after it shall have become a law.
