AN ACT to amend the environmental conservation law, in relation to requiring a reduction in sulfur for all heating oil used in non-attainment areas

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 Section 1. The environmental conservation law is amended by adding a 2 new section 19-0318 to read as follows:
- S 19-0318. SULFUR REDUCTION REQUIREMENTS.
- 4 ON OR AFTER JANUARY FIRST, TWO THOUSAND ELEVEN, ALL HEATING OIL SOLD 5 FOR USE WITHIN A NON-ATTAINMENT AREA, AS SUCH AREA IS DEFINED IN THE
- 6 FEDERAL CLEAN AIR ACT, SHALL NOT HAVE A SULFUR CONTENT GREATER THAN
- 7 FIFTEEN PARTS PER MILLION.
- 8 S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
